## LADIES' CUPS AND COMPETITIONS

*Players on handicaps above 40.4 are still eligible to play in these competitions but must play on an Index of 40.4.*

**Gaisford Cup:** Open – match play.

**Nancy McCormick Foursomes:** Choose own partners. Half combined handicap – 36 holes over two rounds of 18 holes.

**Galpin Cup:** Open – the best nett medal of 2 monthly medals count towards the aggregate best 6 nett scores.

**Crawford Cup:** Silver points Cup. Most points gained over season in all competitions.

**Hirst Cup:** Bronze I Points Cup. All competitions as above.

**Simpson Cup:** Bronze II Points Cup. As above.

**Rhodes Cup:** Bronze III division.

**Stableford Cup:** Open – best 5 cards out of 7.

**Par Cup:** Open – best 4 cards out of 6.

**Eclectic:** Silver and Bronze. Total best gross score for each hole over the season.

**Nett Eclectic:** Less full handicap. Silver & Bronze.

**Championships:** Silver, Bronze I, Bronze II, Bronze III – 2 out of 3 qualifying rounds.

**Mary Turner Cup:** Best 2 aggregate nett scores in championship qualifying rounds – Silver, Bronze I & Bronze II.

**Morrison Rosebowl:** Mixed Canadian Foursomes 27 holes.

**Silver and Bronze Medals:** Lowest aggregate of 4 nett scores in LGU medal rounds.

**Pot Pourri:** 18 hole mixed foursomes – draw for partners.

**Putting Cup:** Best 5 cards of 8 LGU medal rounds.

**McGruer Cup:** Open Match play on handicap. Best 2 of 3 qualifying rounds to be played in first 3 rounds in March/April.

**Coronation Medal:** Silver. New Zealand wide Medal Competition.

**Aotearoa Cup:** Silver & Bronze. New Zealand wide Medal Competition.

**Frae-Ona Cup:** Best 2 aggregate scores from 4 rounds. Handicaps 28-40 and inclusive at time of play.

**Ann Poppe Salver Championship Flights:** Losers of first round championships including players who receive byes and semi-final players.

**Susan Marshall Tray:** Losers of first rounds of Gaisford and McGruer Cups. Match play.

**Burne Cup:** Saturday Points competition. Open to both Wednesday and Saturday members, to be played on men's competition of the day.

**Shootout:** To be decided.

**Summer Cup:** Eclectics. Nett competition Maximum Handicap of 40.4.

**Jeanette Beilby Memorial Cup:** Best 2 out of 3 stipulated stableford rounds.

**MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES 2012**  
**SUBSCRIPTION TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

<i>Full Playing</i>	Full playing voting rights
<i>Full Playing Country</i>	Must reside 40km or more from course. Full playing and voting rights.
<i>Dual Member</i>	Any person who is a full member of another club and who has not been a member of this club during the last five years. No voting rights.
<i>Nine Hole</i>	May play 9 holes on any day of the week. Tournaments and Saturdays at the discretion of the Club Captain. Voting rights.
<i>Student 18</i>	Must be attending a university, polytechnic college or secondary school and over the age of 18 and under the age of 23 on 1 March. Full playing rights, voting rights.
<i>Student U18 &amp; U23</i>	Must be under the age of 18 on 1 March full playing rights, voting rights.
<i>Junior</i>	Must be attending a primary school. Full playing rights. Voting rights.
<i>Associate</i>	Must pay affiliated green fees when playing. Can not have been a member of any other category within the past 12 months. May play tournaments. Voting rights.
<i>Summer</i>	Full playing rights between Closing Day (1 November) and Opening Day (1 March). No voting rights.
<i>Non-Playing</i>	Social member. Play restricted to mixed opening and closing days. No voting rights.
<i>Remote Location</i>	Must reside 100km or more from course. Full playing rights.

1. Subs are set at the AGM and are due 1 April. Unpaid subs as at 31 May where no payment arrangement has been made with the membership officer (refer clause 2), will incur the following:

- A 10% penalty
  - Playing rights removed along with handicap details until the subscription is paid in full including the penalty charge.
2. Membership categories of Full playing, Country & Nine Hole can pay by instalments, under the following conditions:
    - Payment arrangements are to be made direct with the Membership Officer
    - A 25% deposit must be made by 31 May
    - The balance can be paid by instalments providing the full sub is paid by 30 November
    - A \$20.00 administration fee will be added to the applicable subscription if this option is taken up.
  3. A Summer member who goes on to become a Full Playing member the following season and hasn't been either a Full playing, Country or Nine Hole member in the past 3 years will have 50% of their Summer subscription deducted from the following season's Full playing subscription.
  4. Beginning golfers and those who have not been a member of a golf club for the past 5 years will pay a half subscription for their first year. This excludes Remote, Juniors, Students, Dual and Associate members.
  5. Associate membership. This category would provide the member the ability to maintain a handicap. They would pay affiliated green fee rates each time they played golf. The following conditions would apply:
    - An Associate member cannot have been a member of any other MGC category the previous season (except Non-playing).
    - A member cannot exceed 5 years of Associate membership.
    - If an Associate member chooses to join either Full playing, Country or Nine Hole their sub would be discounted by 25% for that first season
    - Entry is at the committee's discretion.
  6. A member joining after 30 September will pay half the applicable subscription for all categories, except Summer Membership. Remote location category will pay half fees from 1 January.

Morning rounds may be played and are eligible for the day's competition but these players must be through 9 holes before 11am and must notify Club Captain beforehand.

## **COURSE ETIQUETTE**

The etiquette of golf only calls for a display of ordinary sportsmanship and good manners. It is quite certain that the strict observance of this important phase of the game will create harmony and good fellowship in our club.

1. No one should move or talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or hole when the player is making a stroke.
2. No player should play until the party in front is out of range.
3. When the result of a hole has been determined players should immediately leave the green.
4. Players looking for a lost ball should wave following players through and stand aside.
5. Walk briskly between shots and help speed up the game.
6. Players should carefully repair all pitch marks on the green.
7. Use rakes to cover indentations before leaving a bunker.
8. Replace divots on the fairway and in the rough.

## **CARDS**

The attention of members is drawn to the correct method of keeping the score, that is that the player keeps his opponent's card and enters the score after each hole. At the end of the round the player is responsible to see that his card had been filled in correctly, signed by the scorer and the score entered on the day's competitions sheet.

Incorrect cards or incorrect entry on competition sheet will not be accepted.
